BACKGROUND

India stands at a defining moment in its journey towards becoming a Viksit Bharat by 2047. As one of the world's largest producers of cereals, fruits, vegetables, dairy, and spices, the country possesses a strong foundation to ensure both food safety and security for its 1.4 billion citizens. Over the years, India has made significant progress through landmark initiatives such as the National Food Security Act (NFSA), Poshan Abhiyaan, Eat Right India Movement, and the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana, which are strengthening nutrition access, improving safety standards, and modernizing food systems.

India's agricultural exports have reached historic heights over the last decade, showcasing the country's strength as a global supplier of high-quality agri-produce. From staple grains to high-value horticulture, India is the largest exporter of rice in the world, shipping \$11.83 billion worth—both Basmati and non-Basmati—accounting for over 30% of global rice trade. It is also the largest producer, consumer, and exporter of spices, contributing around 37% of the global spice market with renowned varieties such as turmeric, pepper, cardamom, cumin, and chilli. In the tea sector, India ranks second in the world, exporting 255 million kilograms annually to major markets worldwide. Alongside these, India is the second-largest producer of fruits and vegetables, supplying mangoes, grapes, pomegranates, bananas, and a wide range of fresh and processed horticultural products to international buyers.





Sustaining this leadership demands a strong focus on delivering safe, high-quality, and globally compliant produce. This means meeting Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs), maintaining robust phytosanitary measures, monitoring for contaminants, and adopting advanced technologies to enhance product safety and shelf life. Addressing post-harvest losses, improving storage and processing, and harnessing innovations in biotechnology, digital agriculture, and cold-chain infrastructure are essential to securing both national food safety and international market competitiveness.

To drive this vision forward, BCC&I and ICAR-NRCG are jointly organizing Nourish India 2025: Food Safety & Security Leadership Summit on 20th November 2025 in New Delhi. Under the theme “VIKSIT Bharat Through Innovation and Exploring Opportunities in Food Safety & Security”, the summit will unite policymakers, regulators, industry leaders, scientists, startups, and farmers to shape a safer, more sustainable, and globally competitive food ecosystem for India.
