**The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCC&I)**, one of the oldest institutes of its kind in India dating back its origins to 1833, is presenting a **Pan India Award on Energy Efficiency and Resource Utilisation**.

**Energy efficiency is called the “first fuel” in clean energy transitions**, as it provides some of the quickest and most cost-effective CO<sub>2</sub> mitigation options—as reported by International Energy Agency<sup>1</sup>. **Resource Efficiency and Energy Efficiency offers a powerful and cost-effective tool for achieving a sustainable future.**

India is actively pursuing energy efficiency and resource utilization as a key strategy for sustainable development, with government initiatives, technological advancements, and increasing awareness contributing to significant energy savings and reduced environmental impact.

## Process

- Applications will be online.
- BCC&I designated evaluator will identify the finalists to be submitted to the Jury.  
**(Last date of application is 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025)**

## Framework

- *Presentations will be organised wherein the participants will meet the Jury in person in Kolkata/Delhi (online option would be provided).*
- *Winners will be awarded at the 18th Annual Environment and Energy Conclave of BCC&I on 4th September 2025 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi.*
- *The finalists will be felicitated during the Conclave.*

- All Award Participants will be provided an exhibition desk which will include (a digital screen, one table and chair each and a standee) at the Conclave to facilitate B2B connects.
- Certificate of Participation will be provided to all applicants at the Conclave.

**Award Participation fee is Rs. 25,000 + GST**

### Note:

- **Travelling and Accommodation for joining the Conclave will be borne by the applicants.**
- **It would be preferred that exhibitors bring their respective organizations' standee so that usage of single use flex standee can be minimised.**



## The Award Categories are:

- **Large Industry**
- **MSME** (Definition as per Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India)
- **Start Up** (Definition as per the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade under Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India)

A Jury invited by BCC&I will judge the applications. An Independent Evaluator shall assist in evaluation.

BCC&I has been working with Country Partners in facilitating B2B connects in Clean Energy and Sustainability space including E-mobility and Built Environment among others.
