

# Number of Japanese Companies in India: 1,400 Cos. (4,901 locations)




## Japanese Investment In India






## Trends in the Percentage of Companies in the Black




## 70% of Japanese companies in India to expand



- Results of joint projects are mostly not patented in India (for US, Europe, China, Korea's domestic market?)






