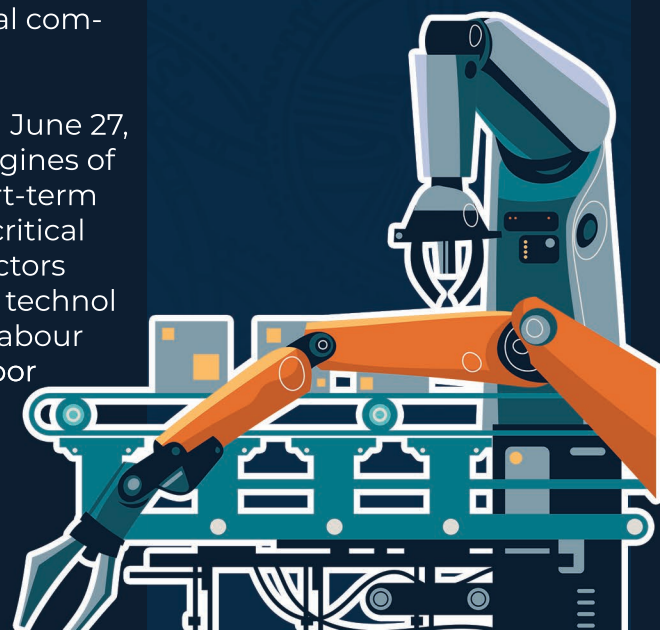


EVENT OVERVIEW

The 5th Edition of World MSME Day, to be hosted in Kolkata on 27th June 2026, will establish the city as the premier convening hub for Eastern India's MSME growth agenda. Leveraging Kolkata's rich industrial legacy, strategic port connectivity, robust financial ecosystem, and role as a gateway to Southeast Asia, the event will unite stakeholders from West Bengal, Odisha, Bihar, Jharkhand, Assam, and the North-Eastern states. This regional platform will foster collaboration to transition MSMEs from survival-focused relief to sustainable, high-value manufacturing, technology integration, and innovation-led growth.

The event will also strengthen international cooperation through focused Indo-African, Indo-German, and Indo-British collaborations along with other country collaborations, enabling MSMEs to access global best practices, technology partnerships, green industrial solutions, skilling models, market linkages, and cross-border investment opportunities. These strategic international engagements will position Eastern India's MSME ecosystem within emerging global value chains and promote greater trade, sustainability, and industrial competitiveness.

World MSME Day aligns with the global observance on June 27, commemorating the UN's recognition of MSMEs as engines of economic resilience. This edition shifts focus from short-term subsidies to long-term structural reforms, addressing critical challenges such as inadequate skilling in emerging sectors including AI, EVs, advanced manufacturing, and green technologies; weak policy execution; escalating energy costs; labour inefficiencies; and logistics bottlenecks arising from poor last-mile connectivity and fragmented supply chains.

STRATEGIC IMPERATIVE AND NEW INTERVENTIONS

MSME policies in India have traditionally concentrated on short-term relief measures such as credit guarantees, tax incentives, and subsidy support, while comparatively less emphasis has been placed on long-term competitiveness, technology upgrading, and global market integration. A strategic shift is now essential — transforming MSMEs from low-value, fragmented production units into globally competitive enterprises engaged in high-value manufacturing, innovation, and export-oriented growth. Priority sectors include precision engineering, electronics assembly, agri-tech-enabled food processing, design-led consumer products, renewable energy components, bio-plastics, EV supply chains, and pharmaceutical intermediates.

The 5th Edition of World MSME Day, Kolkata 2026, proposes a collaborative international framework by integrating Indo-African, Indo-German, and Indo-British partnerships into Eastern India's MSME ecosystem. These collaborations will facilitate technology transfer, market access, sustainable industrial practices, skilling partnerships, and participation in global value chains. Drawing lessons from leading international models — Germany's Mittelstand-driven industrial excellence, the United Kingdom's innovation and creative manufacturing ecosystem, Africa's emerging trade and market integration opportunities under AfCFTA, Japan's Kaizen-led productivity systems, China's supply chain integration capabilities, and Vietnam's export-oriented skilling ecosystem — the Kolkata edition will unveil a Practical Roadmap for International MSME Collaboration in Eastern India.



KEY INTERVENTION AREAS INCLUDE

Global Skilling & Workforce Development: Establishment of AI-enabled and industry-linked training hubs for youth in EV assembly, drone technology, industrial automation, biotech, and advanced manufacturing, in collaboration with Indo-German technical institutions,

International Cluster Development: Development of sector-focused industrial clusters with shared R&D, testing labs, and green infrastructure, connected to global manufacturing ecosystems and export supply chains.

Green & Sustainable Manufacturing: Joint Indo-German initiatives on renewable energy integration, energy-efficient MSME operations, solar micro-grids, circular economy solutions, and low-carbon manufacturing practices.

Technology & Industry 4.0 Adoption: Promotion of AI-driven predictive maintenance, blockchain-enabled supply traceability, IoT integration, robotics, and 5G-enabled smart manufacturing through international technology partnerships.

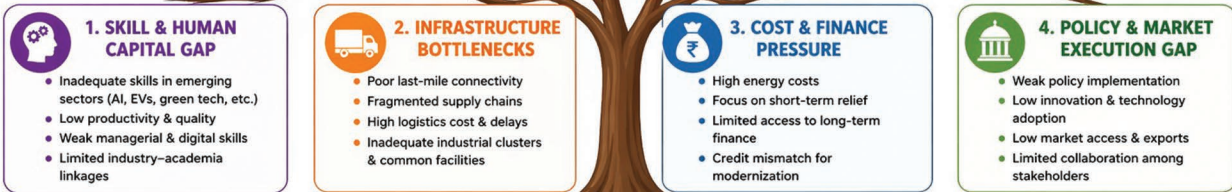
Cross-Border Trade & Market Access: Creation of MSME export facilitation platforms, Indo-African trade corridors, Indo-British buyer-seller engagements, and ASEAN-Africa-Europe business matchmaking initiatives to enhance exports and global sourcing opportunities.

Integrated Logistics & Supply Chain Connectivity: Strengthening multimodal logistics linkages connecting Kolkata Port with industrial corridors, inland freight hubs, and international trade routes to improve efficiency, reduce costs, and support export competitiveness.

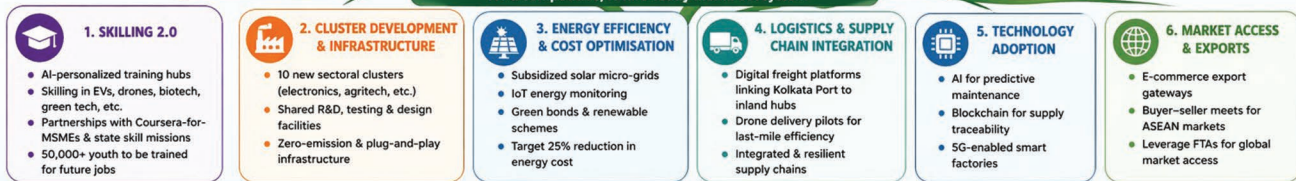

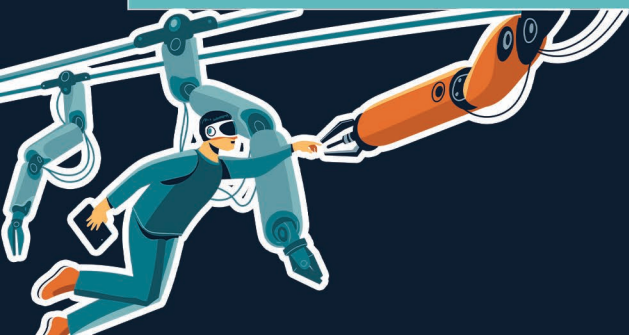
