As India surpasses China to claim the title of the world's most populous nation, our economy stands to harness and capitalize on this demographic dividend, characterized by a substantial working-age population and an expansive consumer market that presents lucrative opportunities for Indian manufacturers and service providers, global brands and trade partners. In addition, supported by the Government's relentless efforts to transform India into a manufacturing powerhouse and considering the shifting geopolitical landscape that has led to a search for alternative supply chain options away from China, India can potentially emerge as the global manufacturing leader in the medium to long term.

Setting aside cyclical fluctuations, India has now established a consistent pattern of robust growth. In the ten years preceding the Covid-19 pandemic, our average annual GDP growth stood at 6.6 percent, surpassing the 6.3 percent growth rate of the previous decade. According to analyses conducted by prominent research organizations, if India can sustain this momentum, it is projected to surpass Germany and become the world's fourth-largest economy by 2026. Furthermore, by 2032, India is expected to surpass Japan and claim the number three position in terms of global economic rankings.

The Chamber has recently initiated several meaningful initiatives to serve as a valuable information hub for its stakeholders, as would be evident from this newsletter. One particularly noteworthy event was the IPR Conclave held at Mumbai, a pioneering endeavor by the Chamber, aimed at enhancing the intellectual property rights ecosystem hosted in the country's business capital. Furthermore, as part of our ongoing commitment towards promoting sustainability, The Chamber organized an event titled 'Multi-stakeholder Dialogue for Collaborative Actions on Sustainability and SDGs'.

INDIA IPR CONCLAVE : FROM RIGHTS TO VALUE



India has been experiencing rapid economic growth in recent years, and its potential for further growth is immense. One of the ways in which India can fuel this growth is by leveraging its intellectual property rights (IPR) regime. Intellectual property is a key driver of innovation, and innovation is the engine that powers economic growth.

With India poised to become a Global Economic Power and an emerging innovation hub, and in the context of the current G20 Summit being hosted by India, it is crucial to raise awareness and understanding among various sections of society as to the importance and value of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Geographic Indicators (GI), and how to protect our own intellectual properties in today's technology driven world.

The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCC&I) organized India IPR Conclave – From Rights to Value, focusing on Intellectual Property Rights in India. The conclave was held at Yashwantrao Chavan Centre, Mumbai on Friday, 28th April, 2023. The programme was partnered with VCAN a Citizens-Government engagement organisation.

The Conclave was addressed by the policymakers, think-tanks, academia, industry and other relevant stakeholders who are

interested in strengthening the country's Intellectual Property Rights ecosystem.

Some of the eminent speakers who took part in the conclave are:

- Smt. Ashwini Bhide, IAS, Addl. Municipal Commissioner (ES), Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation and MD Mumbai Metro Corporation

In the inaugural session, Shri Sanjeev Sanyal, Member of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister of India and Hony. Member, The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCC&I) said that India has quadrupled its throughput in patenting innovations in last five years. He also said that process reform is a major focus area of the Government as ease of doing business is highly reliant on that. He informed

the audience that there has been a landmark process reform going on in patent offices across the country. Referring to statistics he said that as soon as process reform has commenced at Indian patent ecosystem, there has been a dramatic change. Earlier, Indians did not even bother to applying for patent for their innovations. In 2015-16, number of applications for patent were 45,444 and out of which only 29% were from Indian companies or persons, rest were filed by multinational companies. Due to the increasing awareness on protecting innovations and process reform, the applications in last 5 years jumped by 100% and more than 50% were from Indian companies or persons.

Prof. (Dr.) Unnat P. Pandit, Controller General of Patents, Designs & Trade Marks (CGPDTM) who has been leading the execution of process reform in the patent office's said that the mission of "Amrit Kaal" is to revolutionize Indian innovations and due to the Government initiative now India is the third largest start-up ecosystem of the world and many of them turned unicorns.

As part of the overhauling and accelerating the entire Indian patenting ecosystem, there will be 400 Controllers and 100 Examiners, additional 525 posts in next 3 years and 210 contractual posts of Technical Assistants to the Controllers only for strengthening patent ecosystem. 580 contractual posts have been sanctioned for trademarks and 40 contractual posts of Consultant, Senior Research Associates, Research Associates and Young Professionals were hired for fast-tracking the process. Shri. Sanjeev Sanyal also added that there will be Legislative changes too for fixing the timeline for pre-grant opposition.

Dr. Rajani Kant, Padma Shri Awardee and who is an eminent GI Expert gave a special address to the conclave and spoke of making consumers aware about the geographical uniqueness of GI tagged products as it is important for protecting Indian craftsmanship and at the same time creating sustainable livelihood. Not only consumers even craftsmen of India are not aware of what wonders they have been creating since decades. So, it is not only the responsibility of the Government, Dr. Kant added that citizens' organizations play major role in such initiatives

Smt. Indrani Malkani, Chairman, V Citizens Action Network (VCAN) introduced the distinguished speakers participating in the conclave and set the context of the day's proceedings with her opening address.

Apart from the inaugural session, the conclave had a business session oriented towards "Discussion on Patent, Designs, Trade Marks, GI and Addressing Counterfeit: Evolving Role of Industry, and other Stakeholders". This session was moderated

by Shri Deb A Mukherjee, Former President, The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BCC&I) and Trustee, V Citizens Action Network (VCAN). The other panelists were Dr. Vinodh Mewani PhD, Leader – Intellectual Property, Mahindra and Mahindra and Shri. Nishad Nadkarni, Partner, Khaitan and Co.

Shri Munish Sudan, Head, Intellectual Property & External Research Collaborations, Tata Steel Ltd. had given his Industry address on "Green Intellectual Property – A Way Forward towards Sustainability"

The Conclave brought together experts, practitioners, and stakeholders in the field of intellectual property rights who share their insights, experiences, and best practices, providing valuable perspectives on leveraging technology for effective management of IPRs and GI and their take on latest trends.

India IPR Conclave looked to enable the interface of government with citizens at large, civil society organisations and entrepreneurs. Through the interactions, the endeavour was to make possible a practical understanding of the shortcomings and challenges faced in the current usage of technology and to learn about recent initiatives taken by the Government and how an enabling policy ecosystem will be instrumental for smoothening the IPR process.

Overall, India's moment is now, and leveraging its IPR regime can help drive economic growth and position the country as a global leader in innovation and entrepreneurship. Overall, leveraging IPR can help India fuel economic growth, create jobs, and become a leader in innovation. By promoting innovation, strengthening IPR laws, promoting technology transfer, supporting startups, and increasing awareness, India can realize the full potential of its intellectual property assets.

The International Trade Committee of the Bengal Chamber organised the **Online Workshop on Foreign Trade Policy 2023**.

This Trade Policy was long awaited and when finally released was much in news as the Union Minister of Commerce and Industry, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Textiles launched the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023 which has come into effect from 1st April, 2023. This is a policy document which is based on continuity of time-tested schemes facilitating exports as well as a document which is nimble and responsive to the requirements of trade.

FTP 2023, announced on 31st March 2023, sets a **\$2 trillion target for exports of goods and services by 2030** with a shift of focus from “Export Incentives” to “Remission of Taxes” and **entitlement-based regime**. The Policy also aims at creating

district hubs and facilitation measures for E-commerce activities.

In order to Critically analyse the potential of FTP 2023 in boosting India’s export competitiveness and making the country a key player in the global trade landscape and also to understand the implications of FTP and its procedures the Bengal Chamber arranged the workshop for the benefit of the Exporters and Importers

The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry has consistent focus on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 2030.

On 8th May 2023, The Centre for Responsible Business and The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry organized the meeting on Multi-Stakeholder Dialogue for Collaborative Actions on Sustainability and SDGs. The panel for the program consisted members of the West Bengal Government, Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and Industry Stakeholders from various horizons of business.

The Objective of the meeting was to bring together industry stakeholders for discussion and identifying potential collaborative areas with the government to achieve the SDGs collectively as a State and promote awareness regarding SDGs across the country.

The core points of discussion of the meeting were as under:

- ❖ The event primarily has sent the message of localizing the activities through enablers of SDGs like Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) as achieving SDGs is not a singular approach only to be carried out by the UN, but integration of the goals needs to be localized and addressed strategically keeping note of strengths and limitations.
- ❖ The world is in crisis with respect to SDG's as per part 1 of sustainability report of 2022. SDG's are for everybody however mostly people are unaware of SDGs. This is to be addressed by showcasing business practices which are innovative. India Ranks 121 out of 163 UN Member countries. India is critical in achieving

the global SDG goals. Chief Guest, Smt. Vandana Yadav pointed out that West Bengal is frontrunner in six SDGs. Social Initiatives by the West Bengal Government such as, SwasthaSathi, LakshmirBhandar, SobujSathi, Kanyashree (recognized as best practice by UN) to improve the standard of living of the citizens and thereby contributing to the economy. Additionally, she also encouraged industry stakeholders to collaborate in terms of business ventures to increase cash flow in the sustainability development sector and generate other sources of funds than CSR.

- ❖ On a policy making level, the the discussion was that the policy makers should holistically project their focus on the 3 Es- Ecology, Economy and Environment.
- ❖ Adherence to ESG during the entire process of supply chain is crucial. Any Collaboration should be meaningful, and the parties will have to be considerate and thoughtful about it.
